ELIGIBILITY FOR UG ADMISSION

1. Those candidates who are “Eligible for Higher Studies” as per the Higher Secondary Examination and those who have passed in the equivalent examination are eligible for admission to degree programmes,
2. BSW, B.A. English & B. Sc Psychology HSE or equivalent with any combination
3. B. Sc Computer Science HSE or equivalent with mathematics/statistics/computer science/computer application as one of the subjects.

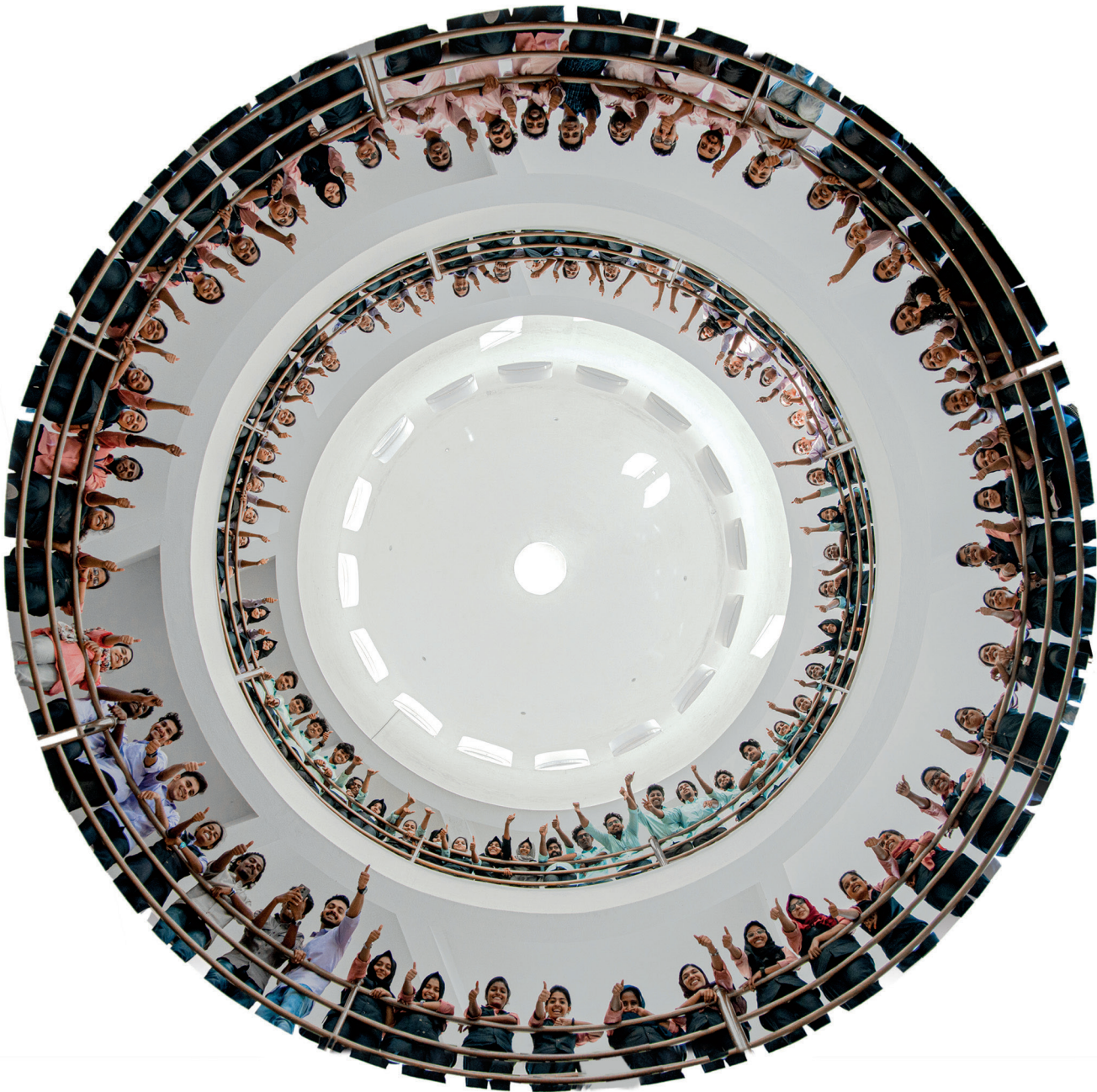


ELIGIBILITY FOR PG ADMISSION

1. Those who are applying for MSW programme should appear for the entrance examination conducted by the University of Calicut. The Minimum mark for admission is 50% in Degree any.
2. Those who are applying for MAJMC programme should appear for the entrance examination conducted by the University of Calicut. The Minimum mark for admission is 45% in Degree any.
3. Those who are applying for MSc Psychology should have minimum 50% mark in BSc or BA Psychology.
4. Those who are applying for M Com should have minimum 50% mark in B Com.
5. Those who are applying for M A English should have minimum 50% mark in any Degree.

Admissions for PG programme are conducted as per the schedule of The University of Calicut. Single Window Registration is mandatory for both Management and Merit Admissions. For registration please visit: www.cuonline.ac.in,

For MSW & MAJMC the University Entrance Examination must be qualified.
